



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FROM INDIVIDUALS / COMPANIES INTERESTED IN PROVIDING PUBLIC BROADBAND WIRELESS ACCESS SERVICES IN THE LOWER 700 MHz, 12 GHz AND 28 GHz BANDS

As part of its continuing effort to open the telecommunications and broadcasting sectors to competition in Trinidad and Tobago, the Telecommunications Authority of Trinidad and Tobago will commence a competitive process for individuals / companies interested in providing *public* Broadband Wireless Access (BWA) services in the following bands, in accordance with the Spectrum Plan for the Accommodation of BWA Services:

- Lower 700 MHz;
- 12 GHz; and
- 28 GHz Bands.

Relevant Concessions and associated Licences for the following *public* services can be obtained through this competitive process:

- Subscription broadcasting services (i.e. “wireless” cable television);
- Internet access services; and
- Public *fixed* telephony services

A Request for Proposals package will be available at the offices of the Authority from *Monday 29th January 2007* onwards during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays.

In order to collect a package, a registration fee of TT\$ 500.00 must be paid to the Authority by way of certified cheque made payable to the ‘Telecommunications Authority of Trinidad and Tobago’ or by cash.

Please note, proposals will only be accepted if submitted by parties (or their agents) previously registered with the Authority in accordance with the stipulations set out above.
