#### **TERMS OF REFERENCE:**

##### **Objectives:**

The incumbent will assist the Authority in the development of specific regulatory frameworks, procedures, and implementation plans as identified by the Authority as key to the further development of the telecommunications sector.

##### **Deliverables:**

- Conducts research in specific areas identified by the Authority;
- Performs the relevant analysis of the existing telecommunications market to determine the feasibility of implementing specific regulatory requirements, taking into consideration the relevant cost implications for stakeholders;
- Performs analysis of the relevant data to inform the development of specific regulatory frameworks and implementation plans;
- Develops and prepares the relevant documentation, reports and findings for review and consultation;
- Provides additional support as may be required

##### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND EXPERIENCE**

- Recognized bachelors degree in Economics, Engineering, Finance or Law;
- Possession of a masters degree in the relevant discipline would be an asset;
- Minimum of five (5) years experience in the telecommunications industry with emphasis on research and policy formulation.
