INVITATION TO APPLY FOR CONCESSIONS TO PROVIDE PUBLIC *WIRED* INTERNET SERVICES

Pursuant to Section 21 of the Telecommunications Act, 2001, the Telecommunications Authority of Trinidad and Tobago is inviting applications for the provision of public Internet services using *wired* facilities. All existing *wired* Internet service providers (ISPs) who do not yet have concessions, and parties interested in offering these services, are invited to apply.

Parties are required to apply for one of the following types of concessions:

- Type 2 - Network-Service Concession (network-based): Authorizes a concessionaire to own or operate a public telecommunications network in addition to providing public telecommunications services over that network.
- Type 4 - Telecommunications Service Concession (service-based): Authorizes a concessionaire to provide a specific public telecommunications service(s) without an authorization to own or operate a telecommunications network.
